

U.S. Open Championship & U.S. Women's Open Championship Fact Sheet

June 9-22, 2014

Pinehurst Resort & Country Club Pinehurst, NC

The U.S. Open Championship and U.S. Women's Open Championship will be held at the Pinehurst Resort & Country Club, Pinehurst No. 2 course designed by legendary Donald Ross. This U.S. Open Championship is one of four major international championships held each year along with the Master's, the PGA Championship and the British Open.

In 1999, the USGA conducted its first U.S. Open Championship at Pinehurst's famed No. 2 golf course, and in a dramatic finale the late Payne Stewart sank a 16 foot putt on the 18th hole to secure the championship. In 2005, New Zealand's, Michael Campbell, claimed the trophy with a par score of 280..

Frequently Asked Questions & Answers

1. ***When will tickets be sold for the U.S. Open Championship?***
The United States Golf Association utilized an application and draw process for ticket allocation, which is normally initiated after the prior year's U.S. Open Championship is completed (in this case late June 2013). The two prior events held in Pinehurst sold out and there no tickets could be purchased at the gate of the championship (except Junior Tickets – see below). 2. ***Will Junior Tickets Be Available?*** Based on past events these tickets would be available at Will Call. Practice Rounds: Age 13 to 17 cost to be determined. Championship Rounds - Age 13-17 cost to be determined. 12 and younger (based on 2005 policy) will be admitted free of charge on any day they are accompanied by a valid adult ticket holder.
3. ***If I'm going to the championship, where can I park?*** For the U.S. Open Championship, designated parking lots and shuttle bus services to the course will be available. An extensive transportation system using hundreds of trail signs will be deployed statewide to help assure seamless travel to the Championship. Statewide signage will direct spectators to satellite parking areas.

It's expected that 120+ complimentary shuttle buses will run continuously from 6 am to 8 pm daily, dropping spectators at the Pinehurst Harness Track across from the Championship grounds. State Highway Patrol officers, along with local law enforcement, will be stationed throughout the area to assure safe, smooth traffic flow.

There is no parking available in and around Pinehurst Resort & Country Club or the Village of Pinehurst for the U.S. Open Championship.

4. ***Is there Airport Transportation?*** Commercial airline service is available via Raleigh-Durham International Airport (RDU), Piedmont Triad International Airport (GSO) and Fayetteville Regional Airport (FAY). The nearby Moore County Airport can accommodate private aircraft up to BACIII, and will provide a hospitality/welcome area for all visitors using that airport.
5. ***Can I play golf during my visit to the 2014 U.S. Open Championships? Will other area attractions be open? YES.*** Moore County has a number of activities and attractions that will be open and available during the U.S. Open Championships. If you would like to play golf in addition to watching championship golf, there are ample golf courses and tee times available. 6. ***Will I have difficulty getting in restaurants during the U.S. Open Championships? NO.*** Reservations are required at some restaurants in the Pinehurst, Southern Pines, Aberdeen Area. There are over 150 restaurants, ranging from pubs to eclectic fine dining. Many of these restaurants do not require reservations and based on the 1999 and 2005 U.S. Open Championships, there is expected to be ample availability. However, if you have a large group or need a specific time (early times are popular), it is recommended you call ahead and make a reservation.
