## COMMITTEE OVERVIEWS

### **Scoring**

*TEEN: Thursday, 7/30 – Saturday, 8/1 | KIDS: Thursday, 8/6 – Saturday, 8/8*

Volunteers assigned to scoring will assist by verifying scorecards at the conclusion of play. Tents will be located near finishing holes where competitors will return their official scorecards. Scoring volunteers will transport returned scorecards to the scoreboard for posting. (Golf knowledge and experience preferred)

### **Shuttle Carts\*\***

*TEEN: Thursday, 7/30 – Saturday, 8/1 | KIDS: Thursday, 8/6 – Saturday, 8/8*

Responsible for transporting players and caddies from green to tee on certain holes t each facility. Multi-passenger carts will be utilized. (Golf knowledge and experience preferred)

### **Contestant Registration**

*TEEN: Wednesday, 7/29 | KIDS: Tuesday, 8/4 & Wednesday, 8/5*

Volunteers will assist U.S. Kids Golf staff in registering contestants. Assistance will also be provided in distributing tournament information and gifts. (Golf knowledge and experience not required)

### **Volunteer Uniform Distribution**

*Thursday, July 9*

Assist in distributing volunteer uniforms and registering volunteers during the orientation meeting. Volunteers are encouraged to sign up for additional committee if available. (Golf knowledge and experience not required)

### **Volunteer Control**

*TEEN: Thursday, 7/30 – Saturday, 8/1 | KIDS: Thursday, 8/6 – Saturday, 8/8*

Assist with checking volunteers in for scheduled daily shifts. This committee will serve to relay information to and from volunteers on the course as well as to monitor volunteer schedules to ensure that all shifts have been covered. (Golf knowledge and experience not required)

### **Supply\***

*TEEN: Thursday, 7/30 – Saturday, 8/1 | KIDS: Thursday, 8/6 – Saturday, 8/8*

Responsible for maintaining appropriate levels of on-course player hospitality stations throughout the tournament sites. (Golf knowledge and experience not required)

### **Pace Marshals / Spotters**

*TEEN: Thursday, 7/30 – Saturday, 8/1 | KIDS: Thursday, 8/6 – Saturday, 8/8*

Pace Marshals will assist rules officials with locating pace of play problem areas.(18 hole courses only) Pace marshals will be positioned on holes #4, 9, 13, 18 (subject to change) at pace checkpoints. Marshals will be responsible for monitoring pace and informing groups of their progress using a color-coded flag system. (Golf knowledge and experience preferred)

Spotters will assist competitors on specific holes throughout a golf course by locating golf balls that may be hit into areas where finding golf balls could be difficult. Spotters will have the ability to contact rules officials in the event a ruling is necessary. Spotters will not comment on or make rulings. Spotters may also be asked to fill-in as relief for pace marshals and/or run lunches to volunteers stationed on-course. (Golf knowledge and experience preferred)

### **Standards**

*TEEN: Sunday, 8/2 | KIDS: Sunday, 8/9*

Volunteers will carry standard signs during the “World Cup.” (Golf knowledge and experience preferred)

\*May be required to lift heavy objects.

\*\*Requires a valid driver’s license.

*The Teen World Championship in addition to the U.S. Kids Golf requires at least 700 volunteers daily across the nine courses involve. If you are willing and able to support both Championships, you will be assigned to the same committee for both weeks. If you are not able to work both weeks, you will be assigned to your first preference where available and your second and third preference if necessary. Thank you in advance for your support!”*
