Holiday Inn Express Undergoing Renovations

The Holiday Inn Express in Southern Pines is in the process of renovating public areas of the hotel. Until renovations are complete, their meeting room, hot breakfast, business center and vending area will not be available. However, the hotel will remain open for overnight guests. The renovations are estimated to take up to 80 days. A representative from the hotel says they will provide cold food items like muffins, yogurt, milk, hard boiled eggs and toast for guests who do stay with them. They wish to express their appreciation and understanding during the renovation phase. The hotel will be prepared for the spring influx of travelers to our area.



Homewood Suites Open During Full Renovation

The Homewood Suites by Hilton Olmstead Village is currently undergoing a complete renovation. Summit Hospitality in association with the hotel are improving all areas of the property including the lobby, office area, pantry, patio/outdoor garden and guest suites. The outdoor renovations are expected to be completed by January with the interior renovation to start soon with completion projected by the end of March. The hotel will remain open during this renovation.



Pinehurst Resort Owner Receives Honor from HHA

Historic Hotels of America has presented the 2019 Historic Hotels of America Steward of History and Historic Preservation Award to Robert H. Dedman Jr., General Partner of Putterboy, Ltd. and owner of Pinehurst Resort. This award is presented to a leader whose passion and dedication to the historic preservation of a legendary hotel will ensure that future generations of travelers can experience its history. Dedman's legacy of historic preservation includes: the restoration of two golf courses, No. 2 and No. 4; the preservation and restoration of Dornoch Cottage; restoration of the Holly Inn (1895) and Carolina Hotel (1901) and reimagining the Manor Inn (1923); the preservation of the historic steam plant building into the Pinehurst Brewing Co.; and numerous other projects.



Golf Digest Ranks No. 4 High Among Public Courses

Golf Digest recently released its 2020 rankings of America's Best New Courses and Pinehurst No. 4 has been ranked the second best public course! Five years ago, Pinehurst hired Gil Hanse to remodel the course which dates back to the 1950s. Last summer, the course served as a companion to the legendary Pinehurst No. 2 to host the 2019 U.S. Amateur. According to Golf Digest: "The course seems to meld itself into the landscape. There are times where you see Course No. 2 next door; the two look like they belong together."
