Pik n Pig makes its triumphant return on Saturday, February 18. The original BBQ establishment at the Gilliam-McConnell Airport in Carthage burned down in May 2021. With help from the community, the airport owners and the will to return, Pik n Pig owners Ashley and Tiffani Shepherd rebuilt the restaurant and are ready to welcome everyone back! The CVB attended a sneak preview on January 27 and we couldn't be more pleased that this legendary BBQ joint is back and will be better than ever!

Painted Ponies Art Walk on Display in SOP Once again, the annual Painted Ponies Art Walk is on display along Broad Street

in downtown Southern Pines. The public art installation is a fundraiser for Carolina Horse Park and will remain on display until early April when the ponies will be auctioned off to support CHP programs. Last year, the event raised more than \$125,000 for the CHP Foundation. This is the fourth year for the program. The CVB purchased two of the ponies this year. One is called "I Wonder" and was painted by advanced art students from Pinecrest High School. The other is called "Where Liberty Dwells" and was painted by local artist Larissa Lycholaj who owns Larissa Ann Fine Art and Curations.

The Magnolia Inn to Reopen February 7





Pinecone Pathways Program to Launch





After a year-long renovation that completely remodeled its guest rooms and interior, The Magnolia Inn, located in the heart of the Village of Pinehurst, will once again be greeting guests on February 7. The Magnolia Inn is the second-oldest hotel in the Village, behind only The Holly Inn, which welcomed Pinehurst's very first guests on New Year's Eve in 1895, just one year before The Magnolia Inn first opened its doors. The Magnolia Inn is owned by Pinehurst Resort and also features Villaggio Restaurante & Bar, a fine dining experience featuring traditional Italian cuisine.

USGA Places Final Beam at Golf House Pinehurst

On Thursday, January 19, it was a beautiful day in Pinehurst for the Topping Out ceremony at the construction site for the USGA's Golf House Pinehurst. The final beam was signed by construction and design teams, along with USGA and Pinehurst Resort staff, and local officials (including the CVB) along with special inscriptions. This was a symbolic and important step toward the completion of Golf House Pinehurst, which is set to open in early 2024. The two buildings will house USGA staff, a testing center, a green grass section, and the World Golf Hall of Fame.

Pinehurst Announces Plans for Tenth Course

Pinehurst Resort has announced that it will be creating a brand-new golf course for the first time in 28 years. Pinehurst's tenth course is set to open in 2024 and will be designed by acclaimed golf course architect Tom Doak. Aside from the golf course, the site in Aberdeen will include a short course, clubhouse, guest cottages and other lodging. Located four miles south of the main resort clubhouse, Doak's 18-hole routing is expected to open late spring of 2024, coinciding with the return of the U.S. Open to Pinehurst No. 2. The new course will incorporate rugged dunes that were mined at the location at the turn of the 20th century, and feature the native sand and wiregrass that are characteristic to the area. Kyle Franz did an amazing job restoring this original Donald Ross course, considered one of Ross' finest creations. According to Golf Digest: "Franz's work injecting greens with bold character, removing trees and painting the layout with the kind of scruffy sandscapes indigenous to the Pinehurst region (and to Pine Needles and Mid Pines where he's previously wielded his art), have elevated this formerly modest public course to the level of its more prestigious neighbors." The Countdown to the 2024 U.S. Open is On

On January 30, we marked that we are now 500 days away from the start of the 2024 U.S. Open at Pinehurst No. 2. To mark the occasion, the CVB has placed a countdown clock on the homepage of our website at www.homeofgolf.com. The 2024 U.S. Open will be the fourth such event contested at the venerable Resort. It previously held the event in 1999, 2005 and 2014. Of course, the 1999 U.S. Open, won by Payne Stewart, is one of the most revered moments in the event's history and immortalized by the One Moment In Time statue which stands overlooking the final hole of No. 2. We are literally counting the days until the U.S. Open returns to the Home of American Golf!
